<p>1 Six days later,</p> <p><u>Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John</u> and led them up a high <u>mountain</u>, by themselves.</p> <p>2 And <u>he was transfigured</u> before them, and his face shone like the sun, and <u>his clothes became dazzling white</u>.</p> <p>3 <u>Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him</u>.</p> <p>4 <u>Then Peter said to Jesus, “Lord, it is good for us to be here; if you wish, I will make three dwellings here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.”</u> 5</p> <p>While he was still speaking, suddenly <u>a bright cloud overshadowed them,</u></p>	<p>2 Six days later,</p> <p><u>Jesus took with him Peter and James and John,</u> and led them up a high <u>mountain apart</u>, by themselves.</p> <p>And <u>he was transfigured</u> before them,</p> <p>3 <u>and his clothes became dazzling white</u>, such as no one on earth could bleach them.</p> <p>4 <u>And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus</u>.</p> <p>5 <u>Then Peter said to Jesus, “Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.”</u> 6 He did not know what to say, for they were terrified.</p> <p>7 Then <u>a cloud overshadowed them,</u></p>	<p>28 Now about eight days after these sayings <u>Jesus took with him Peter and John and James,</u> and went up on the <u>mountain</u> to pray.</p> <p>29 And while he was praying, <u>the appearance of his face changed,</u> and <u>his clothes became dazzling white</u>.</p> <p>30 <u>Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him.</u> 31 They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.</p> <p>32 Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but since they had stayed awake, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him.</p> <p>33 Just as they were leaving him, <u>Peter said to Jesus, “Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah”</u>—not knowing what he said.</p> <p>34 While he was saying this, <u>a cloud came and overshadowed them; and</u></p>

<p><u>and from the cloud a voice</u> said, “<u>This is my beloved Son;</u> with him I am well pleased; <u>listen to him!</u>” 6 When the disciples heard this, they fell to the ground and were overcome by fear. 7 But Jesus came and touched them, saying, “Get up and do not be afraid.”</p> <p>8 And when they looked up, <u>they saw no one except</u> <u>Jesus himself alone.</u> 9 As they were coming down the mountain, <u>Jesus</u> <u>ordered them,</u> “<u>Tell no one</u> about the vision until after the Son of Man has been raised from the dead.”</p>	<p><u>and from the cloud there</u> <u>came a voice,</u> “<u>This is my beloved Son;</u> <u>listen to him!</u>”</p> <p>8 Suddenly when they looked around, <u>they saw no</u> <u>one with them any more,</u> <u>but only Jesus.</u> 9 As they were coming down the mountain, he <u>ordered them to tell no one</u> about what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead. 10 So they kept the matter to themselves,</p> <p>questioning what this rising from the dead could mean.</p>	<p>they were terrified as they entered the cloud. 35 <u>Then from the cloud</u> <u>came a voice that said,</u> “<u>This is my Son, my</u> Chosen; <u>listen to him!</u>”</p> <p>36 When the voice had spoken, <u>Jesus was found alone.</u></p> <p>And <u>they kept silent and in</u> <u>those days told no one any</u> of the things they had seen.</p>
